Q.5 and Q.6 draw from a combined pool of three chapters each. Q.7-Q.9 have fixed chapter pairs for parts (a) and (b) — part (b) is not always numerical, a numerical question can come from either part. Attempt any 3 of the 5 long questions.

- 25% of questions will be open-pick in nature; 50% of short questions come from exercise, and the remaining 50% from full chapters.
