Q.2 (a)	Explanation of couplets from the Nazm (poem) section — explain 2 couplets, plus the poem's and poet's names.	10
Q.2 (b)	Explanation of couplets from the Ghazal section — select and explain 2 out of 3 given couplets, plus the poet's name.	10
Q.3	Explanation of a paragraph with reference to context, including the lesson title and author's name — attempt 1 out of 2 given paragraphs.	15
Q.4	Summary of a lesson — write the summary of any 1 out of 2 given lessons (one from the first half of the book, one from the remaining half), including the author's name.	10
Q.5	Summary of the Nazm (poem), including the poet's name.	5
Q.6	Write an Essay on any 1 out of 3 given topics.	20
Q.7	Write a Letter on the given topic.	10

Attempt every subjective question listed above; choice only applies within the sub-parts noted.
