Q.4	Short questions — Prose (5), Poetry (2), Ghazal (1) offered; attempt any 5 out of 8.	10
Q.5	Summary of a lesson — one from the first half of the prose lessons, one from the remaining half.	5
Q.6	Central idea or summary of the poem (4 marks) plus the poet's name (1 mark).	5
Q.7	Letter or application writing — from Grammar & Composition, pages 59–77.	10
Q.8	Story or dialogue writing — from Grammar & Composition, pages 78–83 and 108–118.	5
Q.9	Correction and completion of sentences — from Grammar & Composition.	5

Attempt every subjective question listed above; choice only applies within the sub-parts noted.
